Action Taken Report AY 2020 - 2021

The suggestion received through the feedback will be promptly communicated to the University of Mumbai and mailed to Council of Architecture.

Feedback on the curriculum was sought and received from the major stakeholders' students, teachers and parents, . The spectrum of parameters used to obtain the feedback was chosen carefully so that an analysis of the same would reveal the strengths of the curriculum, which could be built upon, and also the weaknesses for remedial measures to be instituted.

The parameters chosen allowed both the generic and discipline-specific characteristics of the curriculum to be assessed. The findings from the analysis of stakeholder feedback on curriculum have been communicated to the Management, CDC , IQAC and departmental meeting.

COMMON FEEDBACK SUGGESTIONS BY THE STUDENTS, FACULTY & PARENTS

Sudden outburst of COVID-19 give rise to various issues:

1	Conduction of Studio lecture
2	Conduction of Seminars
3	Discussion, checking and marking
4	Concerns regarding students moving to home town.
5	Concerns regarding unavailability of equipped services, network issues, laptops etc.
6	Concerns about in re-evaluation of papers and allowing them to discuss with faculty to understand the marks given was requested by the student.

Action Taken

1	Online sessions were planned on zoom & google meet.
2	Faculties were monitoring only 6 to 7 students at a time.
3	Individual counselling and mentoring for students at home town was done by all the faculties.
4	In the event that equipment was not available, students were allowed to sketch or complete drawing however they felt comfortable and submit images over WhatsApp.
5	Due to unavailability of stationary materials students were allowed to sketch & prepare drawing on any sketch book/papers.



6	Important repeat sessions for students who could not attend were stringently conducted at regular intervals.
7	Concession in medical issues not only for the student but also in case of family member was considered during the COVID pandemic.
8	Regular meetings were conducted with faculties understand issues for online classes.
9	Concerns about in re-evaluation of papers and allowing them to discuss with faculty to understand the marks given was requested by the student.
10	Concern regarding re-evaluation was granted. As per policy & all the transactions were mailed from examination mail id i.e. skltcoexamcell123@gmail.com .
