The suggestion received through the feedback will be promptly communicated to the University of Mumbai and mailed to Council of Architecture.

Feedback on the curriculum was sought and received from the major stakeholders' students, teachers, alumni, employers and parents. The spectrum of parameters used to obtain the feedback was chosen carefully so that an analysis of the same would reveal the strengths of the curriculum, which could be built upon, and also the weaknesses for remedial measures to be instituted.

The parameters chosen allowed both the generic and discipline-specific characteristics of the curriculum to be assessed. The findings from the analysis of stakeholder feedback on curriculum have been communicated to the Management, CDC, IQAC and departmental meeting.

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON STUDENTS' FEEDBACK

STUDENTS' FEEDBACK			
1		Students suggested that requirement of more interactions and interventions by practising Architects and experts from various interdisciplinary fields	Multiple talk sessions and interactive lectures conducted by Industry experts and Architects. Sessions on various topics like Gender Sensitive Architecture, contextual based architectural responses, etc were conducted. Students benefited from these as they were able to connect and interact with experts from various fields and acquire Hands on experience.
2		Interactive sessions required between different academic years. Introductory sessions required at the commencement of academic year/semester to understand the course and programme.	Student Council formulated and made approachable to students for interactions. Group assignments and activities including sharing of literature and knowledge was encouraged. Project work and files done by the top achievers was collected and documented and shared with students for better understanding. This helped create a healthy competitions amongst students to perform better than their peers.
3		Extra sessions to understand measurement systems and usage of scale; extra studio time is requested.	As this becomes the basis of any drafting studio, faculties were requested and schedules for course - Allied Design, extra sessions and studio hours were added for the students to understand Measurement systems and usage of scales and conversion. Metric scale painted on the studio walls were used to explain and the students to get a on scale experience.
4		Demand for more opportunities for experiential learning that is site visits, field work, case studies, study models etc. was felt.	More opportunities in terms of Field work, on site working exercises, site visits and group work was encouraged within the Students. various MoUs with Industry Experts were signed which allowed students work on various projects by visiting the offices and sites every weekends and on holidays and vacation durations. Value Added Courses based around hands-on workshop and field work were introduced.
5		Inclusion of software skills in the B.Arch programme from the 2nd year.	Faculties and experts were identified. Softwares like AutoCAD, SketchUP and revit were included as a Elective Course. Value Added Course on softwares like Blender and UI/UX were also undertaken.




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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON EMPLOYERS' FEEDBACK

1	EMPLOYERS' FEEDBACK	Employers' suggested that no. of days for practical training should be increased from 120 days to full year.	As internship are as per COA norms and University Of Mumbai prescribed syllabus, HEI identified certain internship options for students that could be conducted as a part of MoU and can be conducted as per weekly or duration vacation times. Experts and Employers were requested to visit the college and conduct research or preparator work during college timings. Also, the Alumni were invited to

Sessions by the experts on Client Budget, preparing of Bills of Quantity, finance management and listing down of documents required for and before project execution	Senior faculties with industry experience were identified to take up courses based on "Project Cost Evaluation" . Various typologies and scenarios were undertaken to explain the experts and reports based work was undertaken.
4		More interactive sessions required by industrial professions in the Design and Construction Market.	Workshops and Market research and Survey were introduced and students were encouraged to visit and collect brochures and samples for further references. Faculties and Parents active in the field were also requested to share the samples and brochures to be collected and displayed in the Material lab. Exhibitions and events organised by vendors and manufacturers were identified shared with students for their participations.
