



Students' Feedback Analysis on Academic Performance and Ambience & Infrastructure

1. Rate the syllabus of the courses that you have studied in relation to the competencies expected out of the course.

Overall feedback on the syllabus of the courses is positive with a majority of the students expressing satisfaction. A significant majority of students comprising 88.8% (34.4% Excellent + 24.4% Very Good + 30% Good) express a positive view regarding the syllabus of the course. A notable 1.1% of students responded with average. While the majority view is positive with overall 100% satisfaction.

2. How do you rate the electives offered?

Most students have expressed satisfaction with the electives. A sizable majority of students—69.8% (16.6% Excellent, 38.8% Very Good, and 14.4% Good) have good opinions of the electives offered by the college. Notably, average responses were given by 30% of the students. Even if the majority of students have positive opinions, overall satisfaction level of the students on electives offered is 100%.

3. Rate the Integration of course material with current events, recent innovations & interdisciplinary topics

Overall, positive remarks on the Integration of Course material with current events & recent innovations have been made by the majority of students. The integration of course material is viewed favorably by a significant majority of students i.e. 76.5% (25.5% Excellent, 38.8% Very Good, and 12.2% Good). Remarkably,23.3% of students provided average responses. The percentage of students that are satisfied with the Integration of Course material overall is 100%.

4. Rate the hands-on learning/ workshops conducted with reference to development of professional skills.

Most students have had favorable things to say about the experiential learning and workshops. A sizable majority of students regard the hands-on learning/workshops i.e. 72% (27.7% Excellent, 28.8% Very Good, and 15.5% Good). Surprisingly, 27.7% of the students gave mediocre answers. There are 100% of students that are happy with the hands - on learning/workshops that are offered overall.

5. Rate the satisfaction level of exposure to professionals in the field of architecture & allied fields and their work.

Regarding the satisfaction level of exposure to professionals in the field of architecture & allied fields and their work, the majority of students have expressed favorable thoughts. The satisfaction level of exposure, majority of students i.e. 94.3% (35.5% Excellent, 30% Very Good, and 28.8% Good) expressed positive views. It is noteworthy that 5.5% of the students gave average response. The satisfaction level of teaching with reference to the courses offered are generally rated well by 100% of students.






